SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Scholarships of \$1,000 each shall be awarded by the VYSA Board to (two male/two female) successful applicants who, for three or more years, have played with a team registered in the District of Vancouver and are currently playing, refereeing, coaching, or involved in administrative work in soccer under the jurisdiction of the VYSA Board.
2. Scholarships shall be awarded to:
 - a) Students proceeding from Grade 12 to any university or post secondary institute approved by the Vancouver Scholarship Selection Committee.
 - b) Students already attending a post-secondary institute, but who are under 19 years of age as of January 1st of the current playing season and were participating within VYSA during the current playing season.
3. Candidates must complete the application in full and provide all required information, documents and letters in order for their application to be considered. It is the responsibility of the candidate to see that the application is complete and that all required information, documentation and letters are enclosed with the application. ***Incomplete applications will be disregarded.***
4. Scholarships are conditional in that the funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he/she is attending a post-secondary institute approved by the Vancouver Scholarship Selection Committee.
5. A candidate must also have shown worthwhile contributions to the sport, as judged by the Vancouver Scholarship Selection Committee, in the area of volunteer refereeing, coaching or club administration.
6. A candidate must have a minimum B average in his/her marks.
7. A candidate must have demonstrated good citizenship, character and leadership.
8. The following must accompany the application:
 - a) Letter from the principal or post-secondary administrator certifying the candidate's age, scholarship, character and ability, as well as participation in school activities.
 - b) Transcript of the student's most recent marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record Card. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the principal's or post-secondary administrator's signature will be accepted.
 - c) Letter from a Coach, Manager or League Executive indicating the candidate's character, leadership, participation in volunteer community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's contribution to refereeing, coaching or administrative involvement within the local soccer community. Volunteerism in soccer can be with a club, a school or community centre program.
9. The Scholarship Selection Committee will not enter into correspondence with an applicant or his agent.
10. The decision of the committee is final.
